

Thank you for your interest in volunteering at the Wanaque Public Library! We currently accept volunteer applications from teens who are in grades 9-12.

We are a small library, so we can't always accommodate all of the students who wish to volunteer. If you're turning in your application during the school year and you don't hear from us within a week, please check back with us in May. There are a lot of opportunities for teens to volunteer during the Summer Reading Program.

Teen volunteers at Wanaque Public Library play an important role, helping with tasks such as:

- collection management (such as shelving items, shelf-reading, sanitizing toys in children's area)
- building maintenance (including dusting shelves, straightening books on the shelves)
- preparing materials for craft and other programs
- helping to set up and clean up after library programs
- assisting patrons during library programs (under the guidance of library staff)

All volunteers are expected to:

- Set up a schedule of times when you commit to be at the library to volunteer.
- Arrive on time for shifts, and stay until the end of shifts. Check in with a library staff
 member when you sign in at the beginning of the shift and when you sign out at the end
 of your shift.
- If you cannot make your scheduled shift, we expect you to contact us as soon as possible to let us know.
- Dress appropriately for the library (no holey jeans, no shirts with offensive logos, etc)
- Be friendly and courteous towards library staff, other volunteens and library users.
- Ask questions if you are not sure whether you understand how to do something.
